Course Pre-requisites

AMLS is ideal for all levels of EMS professionals including: EMTs, Paramedics and Nurses

Certification

Upon successful completion of the course, participants shall receive a certification card valid for a period of 3 years.

A score of 76% is required on the written exam as well as demonstrating proficiency in the assessment evaluation stations.

Continuing Education Credits

AMLS has been approved by CECBEMS for continuing education credits. Pennsylvania has also approved this course for continuing education credits.

Nationally registered paramedics may utilize the AMLS course to cover all medical topics outlined in the Mandatory and Flexible Core Content of the re-registration requirements.

Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) was developed by the National Association of EMTs (NAEMT) and addresses many common medical complaints and offers a "think outside the box" method of addressing and managing a patient suffering a medical emergency. The course emphasizes a methodological approach to patient assessment to identify potential medical problems and guide a diagnosis-based treatment plan.

Goals of the Course

The primary goals of the Advanced Medical Life Support course are to:

- Apply critical thinking skills in order to integrate pathophysiology with the assessment findings of a medical patient.
- Determine and differentiate between actual and potential patient problems.
- Allow the provider to systematically work through a patient assessment and examine the possibilities and probabilities of differential diagnoses.

The following topics are covered during the AMLS course:

- Patient Assessment
- Airway Management
- Assessment of the Shock Patient
- Dyspnea/Respiratory Failure
- Chest Pain
- Altered Mental Status
- Abdominal Pain

Teaching stations follow associated lectures each day.

Evaluation Scenarios include:

- Hypoperfusion
- Dyspnea/Respiratory Failure
- Chest Pain
- Abdominal/GI Bleed Scenarios
