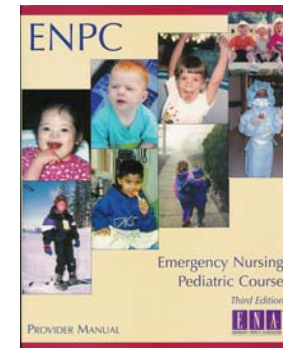

ENPC Course Description:

The ENPC Course was designed to provide nurses with the core knowledge and skills needed to care for the pediatric patient. The course is presented through a series of lectures and four psychomotor skill stations.

Who Should Attend ENPC?

Any Registered Nurse or paramedic involved in caring for the pediatric patient. Verification for the ENPC Provider Course is available to Registered Nurses only. Verification remains current for four years. Paramedics may audit ENPC.

It is strongly recommended that nurses attending ENPC have at least six months of clinical emergency/pediatric nursing experience which is directly related to the assessment and stabilization of pediatric patients. The ENA has approved ENPC for (15.33) CECH's. CEU's through endorsement are available for paramedics, PHRN's.

Successful Completion:

To successfully complete ENPC, the Participant must achieve a minimum of 80% On the written evaluation and achieve at Least a 70% of all steps in the Pediatric Psychomotor evaluation station.

Registration:

Advanced registration is requested at least no later than 10 days prior to the first day of the course. Early registration is advised to allow time to receive pre-course materials. In order to achieve maximum success in ENPC, pre-course preparation is essential. Registration is limited and will be closed when the maximum enrollment is reached. **Registration will not be accepted less than 10 days prior to the course.** Course materials will be mailed prior to the beginning of the course.
