ADVANCED TRAUMA LIFE SUPPORT®

This program was developed by the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma aiming at improving the care given to a trauma patient. This course approaches trauma care in a systematic manner, teaching well-established treatment methods to physicians.

The ATLS® program focuses on the care given to the patient during the "First Hour". Emphasising initial assessment and primary management of the injured patient beginning from point of injury until is stabilized in a trauma center.

Benefits of the ATLS® Program:

- A foundation of common knowledge for all members of the trauma team.
- An organized approach for evaluation & management of seriously injured patients.
- Applicable in both large urban centers and small rural emergency departments.

Course Objectives:

- Assess the patient's condition rapidly and accurately.
- Resuscitate and stabilize the patient according to priority.
- Determine if the patient's needs exceed a facility's capabilities.
- Arrange appropriately for transfer of a patient to definitive care.
- Ensure that optimum care is provided.

+Student /Student Refresher Course:

The provider course is a 2 day course. The course begins at 7:30 a.m. Day 1 and will end approximately 6:00 p.m. Day 2 will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end approximately 6:30 p.m. Course content includes core lectures, case presentations, triage scenarios, hands on skill stations with the utilization of the Trauma Man Simulator, and testing. 19 Category 1 credits are awarded after successfully passing the course.

The refresher course is held on the 2nd day of the provider course. Course registration begins at 12:30 p.m. The course will end approximately 6:30 p.m. The refresher course provides an overview of ATLS updates, triage scenarios, and testing. 5 Category 1 credits are awarded after successfully passing the course.

Students that display instructor potential will be given the opportunity to attend the Instructor Course.

Breakfast, lunch, and nutritional snacks are provided during this course.

Auditors:

Paramedics or Pre-hospital RN's may audit the course and will receive 16 Medical/Trauma continuing education credits upon completion.
