PALS PROVIDER COURSE

Course Pre-Requisites:

Evidence of successful completion of a Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR course (AHA Professional, or ARC Professional Rescuer are acceptable). This information must be forwarded to the GEM-EMI along with the registration form prior to enrollment.

Course Content:

A specific course emphasizing the early recognition and management of the critically ill and or injured child.

This course utilizes lecture, video education, interactive discussion, case study presentation, human patient simulators, and hands on skill and practice teaching stations to assist the student participant in learning the material.
